AED Medical Direction Required by Most State Regulations

Meets Regulations required by most states

Medical Oversight and prescription will be provided by a physician licensed in your state.
Tracking of expiration dates of equipment and training requirements.
Post event review (use of unit) by Licensed Physician for consultation and documentation of event.
Written Site Specific Policy & Procedures Manual.
Coordination and registration of the unit with local EMS. *
AED program is covered by malpractice and liability insurance.

How it works

Each month, a designated person at each facility where there is a defibrillator will receive an email asking them to check for a green flashing light on the front of the unit. The status lights flash every five seconds (green is good-red indicates some further action). That person simply responds back if it was green or red. If green, no further action is needed. If red, we will troubleshoot the unit.

Why use our Medical Oversight Program?

We cover everything listed above along with the following additional benefits.
An AED will be loaned to your company after a use until yours is recovered.
We will post review procedures with your responders to help enhance survival chances.
An analysis of your AED after it has been deployed to insure it is back in ready status.
Assistance in upgrading software to current protocols.

Multiple units at the same site can be added at a reduced cost per unit.
